CEWD Announces New Scholarship Fund

GET INTO ENERGY PROGRAM TO LAUNCH IN 2026

The Center for Energy Workforce Development (CEWD), in partnership with Scholarship America, recently announced the creation of the Get Into Energy Scholarship Fund, a national initiative designed to expand access to energy careers. The fund aims to grow paths to energy employment, addressing financial barriers that hinder access to rewarding careers.

When the program launches in 2026, the fund will include a series of sub-funds that include general scholarship, urban energy, veterans, Hire PowHER, and boosting apprenticeship success (emergency aid fund).


